



The Society of Women Engineers' **Community College Affiliate Support and Expansion (CCASE)** program aims to increase support for existing and the expansion of new Community College Affiliates in the United States. To do this, SWE will directly support professional development and outreach activities through financial and membership incentives. In doing so, SWE will encourage more women in community colleges, especially those underrepresented with extraordinary financial situations, to pursue a STEM degree.

Through the CCASE program, active Community College Affiliates can apply for up to \$750 in project stipends (not to exceed \$375 per request) to conduct professional development and outreach activities and receive up to 10 Collegiate-to-Career (C2C) memberships. New faculty advisors may be eligible for discounted FY25 professional memberships.

The CCASE program is funded by the ARDC Foundation.

CCASE Program Requirements

- Current or newly-formed SWE Community College Affiliate
- Located in the United States
- Members who are interested in or pursuing a STEM degree
- Ability to receive and deposit funds in a bank account, ideally an individual who is your faculty advisor or treasurer.
